NOTICE OF RACE

San Diego, CA USA September 1 – 7, 2013



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1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the rules of the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (STCR). The Organizing Authority is the San Diego Yacht Club in conjunction with the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (ISCYRA). The host fleet is San Diego Bay.

- 1.1. Decisions of the International Jury will be final in accordance with RRS 70.5.
- 1.2. RRS Appendix P will apply.
- 1.3. The prescriptions of the national authority, US Sailing, do not apply except as provided in their prescription to RRS 88.2. Applicable US Sailing Prescriptions are stated fully in Attachment 1.
- 1.4. RRS 32 will be changed to provide that courses will not be shortened.
- 1.5. RRS 33b will not apply.
- 1.6. RRS 35 will be changed to provide that boats not finishing within 60 minutes after the first boat to finish will be scored "Did Not Finish" without a hearing.
- 1.7. RRS 62.2 and 66 will be changed to shorten the time for requesting redress and the requesting that a hearing be re-opened on the last day of racing.
- 1.8. RRS A4.1 will be changed to provide that a boat failing to check in prior to the warning signal will be scored the same as a boat not starting in that race without a hearing.

2. Advertising

Boats may be required to display Event Advertising on the forward part of the hull. Advertising for tobacco products is strongly discouraged.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1. Entries eligible in accordance with STCR 21, 26, 29 and 30 may compete. Qualifications are Log plus two.
- 3.2. Entries shall be submitted on the Official Online Entry Form not later than August 3, 2013.
 Entry shall be made online at http://starclass.org/2013WorldsEntry.php.
 Event website is www.starworld2013.com.
- 3.3. Only skippers and crew eligible to compete under the ISAF Eligibility Code shall be eligible to compete in this regatta.
- 3.4. For the purpose of RRS Appendix A Scoring: A competitor is not considered an entry until: (a) All fees are paid and (b) Measurement is completed.

4. Fees

The entry fee includes boat and trailer parking, launching, hauling and invitations to social events for skipper and crew. The entry fee must be paid by August 16, 2013 and is non-refundable after this date. When payment is received by July 1, 2013 the fee is \$750US. When payment is received after July 1, 2013 the fee is \$850US. Checks must be drawn on a United States bank and made payable to San Diego Yacht Club.





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5. Schedule

- 5.1. Registration and measurement: Wednesday, August 28, 2013, 0900-1600; Thursday August 29, 2013, 0900 – 1700; Friday August 30, 2013 0900 – 1600.
- 5.2. Practice Race: Saturday August 31, 2013.
- 5.3. Schedule of Races: Sunday Friday, September 1-6, 2013.
- 5.4. Reserve days Saturday and Sunday September 7-8, 2013 as per STCR 27.1.
- 5.5. The schedule time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1230.
- 5.6. No warning signal will be made after 1500 on Sunday, September 8, 2013. (See STCR 27.1)

6. Measurement

- 6.1. Measurement will take place at the San Diego Yacht Club Sailing Center. Each participating boat shall have a valid Measurement Certificate in the current owner's name, and Weight Certificate. Only boats that have completed registration, paid all entry fees, and passed the prescribed measurement check procedure by 1600 on Friday, August 30, 2013 are entitled to race. The International Jury may order that a boat be re-checked during the regatta.
- 6.2. Crew shall demonstrate compliance with crew weight limits in accordance with STCR 31.1.3 prior to 1600 on Friday, August 30, 2013. Crews may be re-weighed during the event at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.
- 6.3. Each boat shall show the sail number and national letters as indicated on the Official Entry Form and approved by the Measurer.
- 6.4. Bow numbers will be assigned and given to each participating boat. They shall be affixed to the hull according to the Sailing Instructions.

7. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available during registration and will be posted on the event website.

8. Venue

Racing will be conducted on the Pacific Ocean off the Coronado Roads.

9. Courses

Courses will be according to STCR 34.





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10. Scoring

- 10.1. When four (4) or fewer races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 10.2. When five (5) or more races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores
 - excluding her worst score. 10.1 and 10.2 are deleted in accordance with ISCYRA Class Rules.
- 10.3. Six (6) races are scheduled, of which six (6) races shall be completed to constitute a series.

11. Berthing

Boats shall be at the San Diego Yacht Club commencing at 1600 hours on August 29, 2013 until the conclusion of racing.

12. Haul-Out Restrictions

The Organizing Authority may impose haul-out restrictions

13. Team and Private Support Boats

A yacht shall receive no outside assistance from support boats or otherwise once she has left the dock for the day until the finish of the last race of the day, except in the case of emergency and/or towing supplied by the organizer and available to all participants.

14. Prizes

- 14.1. Perpetual Trophies will be awarded according to STCR 24.
- 14.2. Series prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing first through fifth.
- 14.3. Other awards for first place skipper and crew in the following categories: Master (aged 50-59), Grand Master (aged 60-69), Exalted Grand Master (aged 70 and older), Junior (under age 25), Women, Classic (<7300).
- 14.4. Prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing first through third for each day.

15. Disclaimer

The Organizing Authority shall require each competitor to sign a waiver for loss, damage or injury to persons or property occurring in conjunction with the regatta or on the property of the San Diego Yacht Club. The organizing Authority, their members, employees, officers, and/or agents shall not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur to person or property whether ashore or at sea as a consequence of the participation of any boat.

16. Insurance

Boats sailing in this regatta must be adequately insured against third party liability for racing risks. Proof of same may be requested.

ATTACHMENT 1

Applicable US SAILING Prescriptions (Rx) to the Racing Rules of Sailing

<u>Rx to 88.2</u> After rule 88.2 add:

US Sailing prescribes that sailing instructions shall not change or delete rule 61.4, Appendix R, or its prescriptions to rules 68 or 76.1.

<u>Rx to rule 61.4</u> Add rule 61.4:

61.4 Fees for Protests and Requests for Redress

US Sailing prescribes that no fees shall be charged for protests or requests for redress.

<u>Rx to rule 68</u> After rule 68 add:

US Sailing prescribes that:

- a. A boat that retires from a race or accepts a penalty does not, but that action alone, admit liability for damages.
- b. A protest committee shall find facts and make decisions only in compliance with the rules. No protest committee or US SAILING appeal authority shall adjudicate any claim for damages. Such a claim is subject to the jurisdiction of the courts.
- c. A basic purpose of the rules is to prevent contact between boats. By participating in an event governed by these rules, a boat agrees that responsibility for damages arising from any breach of the rules shall be based on fault as determined by application of the rules, and that she shall not be governed by the legal doctrine of 'assumption of risk' for monetary damages resulting from contact with other boats.

Rx to rule 76.1 After rule 76.1 add

US SAILING prescribes that an organizing authority or race committee shall not reject or cancel the entry of a boat or exclude a competitor eligible under the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions for an arbitrary or capricious reason or for reason of race, color, religion, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, or age.
